



Series title: The Kingdom of God

Session title: The King and His Kingdom

Spend a few minutes thanking and praising God for who He is to us.

Consider: We are very comfortable with God as Father, God the Son as Saviour, and God the Spirit as Helper/Comforter, but we often talk less about God as King and Ruler over His Kingdom.

Read the following scriptures slowly, pray and ask God to reveal Himself through them. Underline anything that stands out and ask God what He particularly wants to say to us through those words.

1 Chronicles 29:10b–13:

Praise be to You, Lord, the God of our father Israel, from everlasting to everlasting. Yours, Lord, is the greatness and the power and the glory and the majesty and the splendour, for everything in Heaven and Earth is Yours.

Yours, Lord, is the Kingdom; You are exalted as Head over all. Wealth and honour come from You; You are the ruler of all things. In Your hands are strength and power to exalt and give strength to all.

Now, our God, we give you thanks, and praise your glorious name.

Matthew 6:9+10 +13b:

Our Beloved Father, dwelling in the heavenly realms, may the glory of Your name be the centre on which our lives turn. Manifest Your Kingdom realm and cause Your every purpose to be fulfilled on Earth, just as it is in Heaven...For You are the King who rules with power and glory forever. Amen.

Discuss answers together.

End with praying Matthew 6: 9+10+13b together.
