WELCOME

City Life Church is home to a number of thriving Church Communities. CHURCH COMMUNITIES

City Life Church is a family of Church Communities across Southampton, sharing everyday life around Jesus. We're committed to creating spaces where we celebrate God and welcome everyone.

We've felt inspired by God to meet together in a new and exciting way. Instead of always gathering as one large group, our church family usually meets in home-sized communities. These 'Church Communities' transform homes, workplaces, and spaces across the city into places where we share life together, invite others in, and make time for God in the midst of everyday life.

Each Church Community is shaped by its members, who share responsibility for when and where they meet, how they practise hospitality, and what they do together. Many start with a shared meal around the table. Others might go for a walk, gather in a park, or meet in other meaningful ways. In this way, church life inspires us to go deeper with God, grow as disciples in leadership and service, and offer a welcoming space for those who don't yet have a relationship with God.

What Defines a Church Community?

- **Home-Sized:** Close-knit groups where deep, authentic relationships can be built
- **Discipleship-Focused:** Journeying together to grow in faith and follow Jesus
- **Everyday Faith:** Doing life with God and one another throughout the week
- **Hospitality-Centred:** Sharing food and life around the table and in other ways
- **Giving & Serving:** Supporting the church with financial giving, time, and spiritual gifts
- **Shared Responsibility:** Everyone plays a part, living out the 'priesthood of all believers'
- **Open to All:** Welcoming people of every age, culture, and background

Why This Way?

As we've followed God's leading, we've stepped away from a traditional congregational model to embrace something more like the Early Church – smaller communities that are Spirit-led, relational, and deeply involved in one another's lives.

This way of gathering allows us to grow naturally, raising up the 'priesthood of all believers' in leadership, service, and mission. The Kingdom of God is lived out through ordinary people doing life with God every day.

We believe this is a fresh and powerful way to live as God's people in today's world.

Our Church Leaders are here to support and encourage every Church Community. They provide teaching resources, Equipping Courses, pastoral care and guidance as well as helping people find ways to serve across the city and beyond. They create a meaningful presence within each Church Community in a few key ways:

Visits

Our Church Leaders make regular visits to each Church Community. These visits are a chance to catch up, share what's on your heart, and hear what's happening across City Life Church.

Gatherings

Throughout the month, City Life Church hosts a variety of Gatherings where Church Communities come together to celebrate all that God is doing among us (see Page 8 for more info). We also hold regular Church Communities Catch-Ups – spaces where our Church Leaders share what they sense God is saying to us as a church family and hear what God is saying to the communities. These Gatherings are a great opportunity to connect with leaders and other Church Communities.

Spiritual Guidance

Our leaders also host Spiritual Growth Days and Equipping Courses throughout the year – offering encouragement and teaching on different aspects of discipleship. These sessions are open to all Church Communities and individuals who want to go deeper in their walk with God.

Healing Prayer

Nicky and Bev also offer Healing Prayer appointments to those needing greater pastoral support at times on their discipleship journey.


Here When You Need Us

Serve

Creating spaces where others feel welcome, whether that's at a meal, a walk, or simply in everyday conversations. We love including friends and neighbours in our lives and offering prayer and support whenever there's an opportunity.

Worship

Making space to worship, pray, and rest, staying connected to God in everyday life. We encourage worshipping God as our first love, pursuing His presence in all of life.

Gatherings



There's always something happening for Church Communities at City Life Church. Our Gatherings are here to help you walk with others and encounter God in the everyday. We offer daily, weekly, and monthly rhythms to support you through every season of life:

Daily

Join us each morning as members of our City Life Family meet online for a simple four-step rhythm of prayer: Pause – Rejoice – Ask – Yield.

Weekly

Come together each week for a welcoming space with reflection, prayer, and worship in God's presence.

Monthly

Celebrate everything God is doing with City Life Church. From family-friendly mornings full of fun, games and stories about Jesus, to spaces that help us grow in our spiritual gifts, to unhurried times of worship – our Monthly Gatherings offer something for everyone.

Community Connections



City Life Church offers practical care and support across Southampton, including for those not yet connected to a church. We partner with local groups to welcome people from overseas and walk alongside those in vulnerable situations. Everyone is invited to play a part by praying, giving, or volunteering. Our Community Connections focus on five main areas:

Homelessness

Providing food, shelter, friendship, and practical help for those experiencing or at risk of homelessness.

Chaplaincy

Offering compassionate, one-to-one pastoral support for people in vulnerable or marginalised situations.

Overseas Welcome

Supporting international students, refugees, and asylum seekers with friendship, practical help, and a warm welcome into community life.

Overseas Trips

Partnering with global communities to share the love of Jesus and offer hands-on support where it's most needed.

Other Connections

Supporting a variety of initiatives making a real difference.
